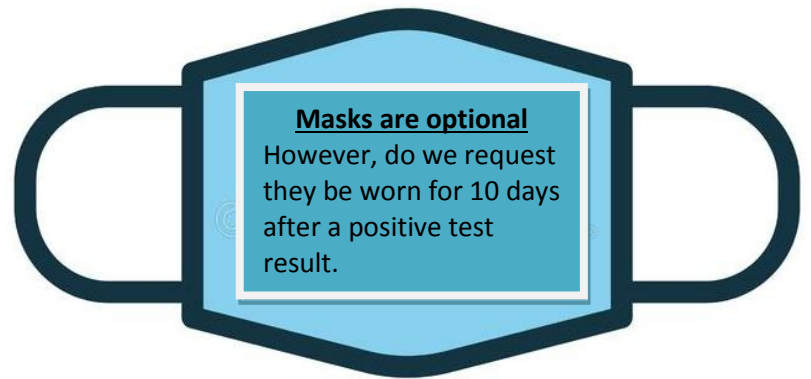


BNG Health and Safety

Please assist us in keeping our students and staff safe and healthy.

- Any child showing signs of illness must be kept home to monitor symptoms.
- Please report all illnesses to BNG.
- Children may return to school after they are fever/symptom free (including vomiting/diarrhea), for at least 24 hours without the use of symptom relieving medications and there are no new or worsening symptoms.
- Children must be free from excessive coughing and/or runny nose.

Children showing any signs of illness at school will be isolated from other children. Parents will be contacted to pick them up. The above protocol must be followed before returning to school.



COVID protocol:

- Covid 19 remains a reportable disease. *All positive cases must be reported to BNG.*
- Please report all exposures so that staff may assist in closely monitoring for symptoms.
- ANY sign of symptoms after exposure- students must be kept home, or will be sent home from school.
- BNG will not administer testing.
- Home testing results are acceptable.
- Families will be notified if there is a close contact at school.
- In case of illness/positive test, students must remain home for at least 5 days after start of symptoms. Students may return to school on the 6th day after the start of symptoms as long as they have been fever free for at least 24 hours without use of symptom relieving medication, and there are no new or worsening symptoms. Masks are requested until the 10th day (or longer if there are residual symptoms).
- BNG continues enhanced cleaning and use of outdoor space to promote health and safety along with healthy hygiene practices and monitoring for illness.
